MAKE THIS SUMMER DIFFERENT, HELP BURMESE REFUGEE CHILDREN IN THAILAND

Are you willing to spend 21 days of your summer break helping with a social project for refugee children? We are looking for volunteers to take part in our 7th Summer Social Project.

This year we will be building a new nursery building in Mae Sot, Thailand, on the border with Burma. Our project will be carried out in association with a Thai NGO. The proposed building is for a school, which provides elementary education for migrant children in the area.

A. Project Information:

Main Objective: To provide a nursery class-room for 40 children in St Peter's school.

B. Project Funding:

Amount required: **£4,600** for the building works plus flight tickets (We expect flights to cost in the region of £550 per person)

Funding: Each volunteer is expected to raise £800. If you are interested in joining the project, we can help you to raise the funds

C. How to raise the money?

Netherhall House raffle: Last year we sold more than £5000 worth of raffle tickets, which went to pay for the project expenses and flights. Two students sold more than £1000 worth of raffle tickets.

Personal sponsorships and Bursaries Funds: It is easy to ask relatives and friends for sponsorship for the project. Last year we raised over £1200 in personal sponsorship.

Teaching English during the summer: If English is your first language, you may want to apply to teach overseas students on the International Summer Course organised by Netherhall House during the month of August.
